

## Math Fact Sites and Apps

To sign into your Google account for Xtra math:

- Go to Google.com
- Type in your [#####@manitowocpublicschools.org](mailto:#####@manitowocpublicschools.org)
- Type in your password
- Then go to mpsd Monroe
- Find Useful links and Xtra math
- Choose sign in with Google and it should load automatically

Apps for phones and tablets (all are free)

Websites

- **AAA MATH** – in the yellow bar on the left hand side, choose Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, or Division. Then choose “Facts” and “Facts for All”. Scroll down to the blue area and click start
- **COMMON CORE WORKSHEETS** – in the blue bar on the left hand side choose the operation you want to practice. Find the one that allows you to practice the basic facts and choose the red button “One at a time”
- **MULTIFLYER** – practices basic multiplication facts. From the “PLAY” button, you can choose to have the grid on/off to assist, and the level. The easier the level the longer time you have to solve the fact.
- **XTRAMATH** – all students have a log in through Google – see above
- **COOL MATH AND HOODA MATH** have some games that practice math facts in a race type setting. Students have played some of these and can find them on their own. These are not the best to practice automatic recall though.

All students now also have a set of white multiplication cards. They have them broken up into two piles: Facts I know within in three seconds, and facts I need to learn or recall quicker. These should stay in their backpack pocket so they are always available to use at home and at school.
