

<b>DRAINAGE BASIN</b>	rivers and streams that drain an area
<b>EROSION</b>	Wearing away of the land by wind, water, ice
<b>LANDFORM</b>	shape or feature of the land, made by mother nature
<b>CANYON</b>	v-shaped valley eroded by a river or a stream

<p>DELTA</p>	<p>deposit of earth material at the mouth of a stream</p>
<p>PLATEAU</p>	<p>large, nearly level area of land that has been lifted</p>
<p>LEVEE</p>	<p>embankment along a stream that protects from flooding, natural or man-made</p>
<p>DAM</p>	<p>a wall that holds back water creating a reservoir or lake</p>

<p>FLOODPLAIN</p>	<p>area round a river that is covered by water flowing over the riverbank during a flood</p>
<p>DEPOSITION</p>	<p>when eroded earth materials settle in another place</p>
<p>SEDIMENTS</p>	<p>eroded earth material that have been deposited</p>
<p>BASIN</p>	<p>low area in where sediments are often deposited</p>

CHANNEL	course water takes in a stream/river
MEANDER	curve or loop in the channel or a stream/river
SLOPE	the slant of a stream channel or land surface

<p>ALLUVIAL FAN</p>	<p>Fan-shaped landform deposited at the end of a steep canyon when the slope becomes flatter</p>
<p>FLOOD</p>	<p>heavy flow or water that goes over the stream's normal channel</p>
<p>FLASH FLOOD</p>	<p>Rises and falls with little or no warning, a result of heavy rainfall</p>
