

AMENDMENT	a change or addition to the Constitution
CANDIDATE	person who runs for a political office
DISTRICT	part if a state
FEDERAL	government shared by both national and state governments

INDEPENDENT	a person who does not belong to a political party
JURY	group of people who decide if a person is guilty of breaking the law
LEGISLATOR	a person elected to make laws
NOMINATE	to name or choose as a candidate

<p>POLITICAL PARTY</p>	<p>a group of people who have a lot of the same ideas about government</p>
<p>REPRESENTATIVE</p>	<p>Someone elected to make laws</p>
<p>REPUBLIC</p>	<p>government in which the people vote for a president</p>
<p>SENTENCE</p>	<p>a judge's ruling that says how a person will be punished</p>

<p>BILL</p>	<p>a written idea for a new law</p>
<p>LOCAL</p>	<p>close to home</p>
<p>VETO</p>	<p>to reject a government bill</p>
